
BATH AND DRYER VENT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



- 1. Secure vent with appropriate nails in nail holes.
- 2. Make sure all nail holes are covered by roofing material.
- 3. Cover as much of the Vent Flange as possible with the roofing material, especially the bottom two corners.
- 4. VERY IMPORTANT! When nailing or stapling the roofing material around our vent DO NOT LET FASTENERS PENETRATE THE VENT FLANGE.
- Do not apply tar or any other asphalt based sealant to the vent. The
 plastic vents are designed to naturally conform to the surface, and do not
 require a sealant when installed properly.
